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# Estimated Tour Cost:

# Passports

- Each member of the tour must have a valid passport.
- Passports must not expire within 6 months of the date of return (Indonesian law)
- A colour photocopy of the details page of each member's passport will be required and kept at the college whilst travelling
- If travelling on anything other than an Australian passport please advise the school before paying your deposit



# Spending money:

- Students will need to take enough

spending money (e.g. \$5000) to cover the cost of their course (e.g. \$5000) and their living expenses (e.g. \$5000) during their course.

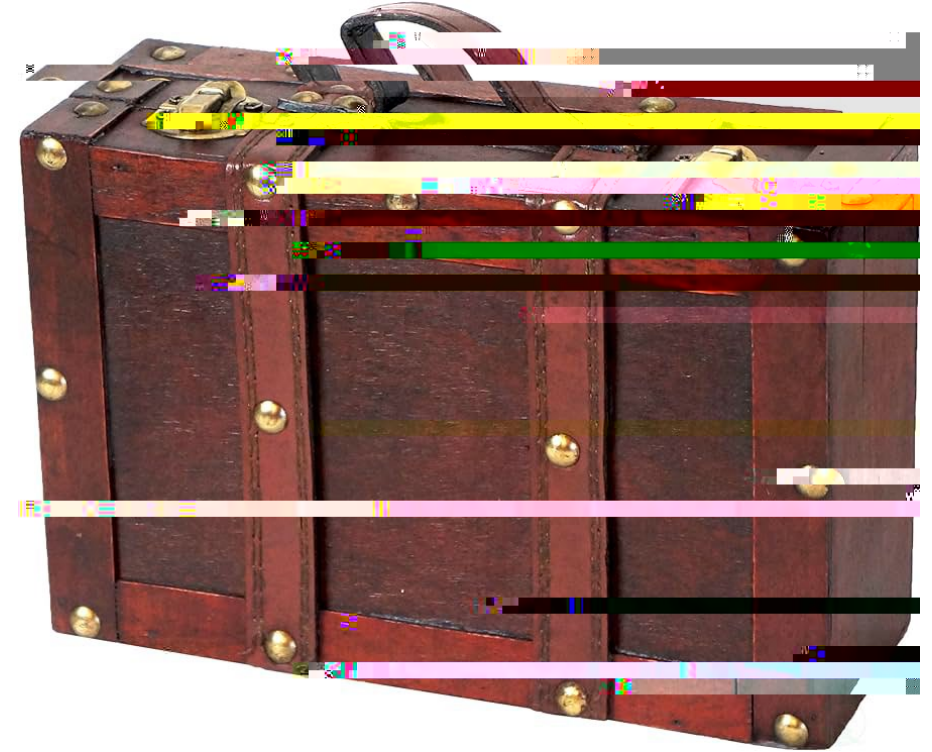




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- Maximum check in luggage weight 23kg

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# Staying in Touch with home:

- Mobile phones – overseas use is expensive, check with your provider re: rates. Check re: prepaid phones and ability to roam internationally
- Phone cards – purchased in Country used to phone back to Australia
- Telstra / Optus international home link account
- Email – the cheapest and best way to stay in touch
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# Student Requirements:
