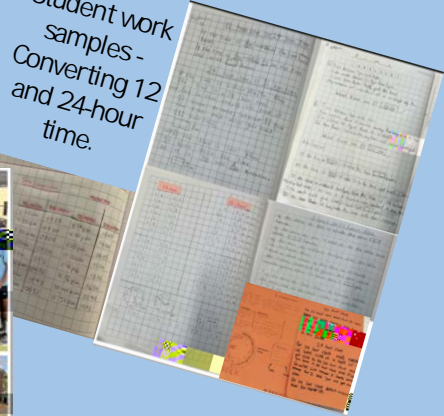
MATHS

56D played a game of Super Shots to learn about data collection and representation. Our athletes and mathematicians did some incredible work!

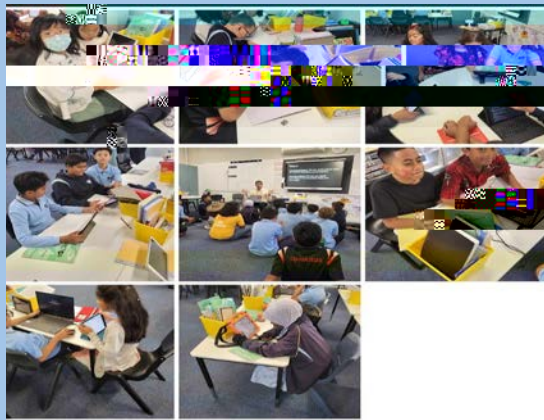

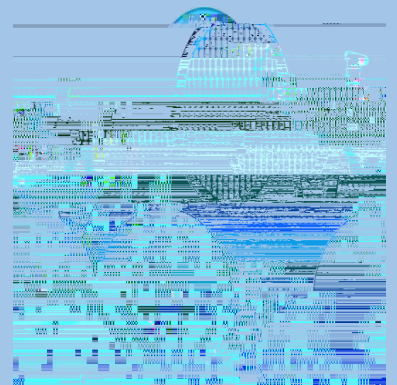
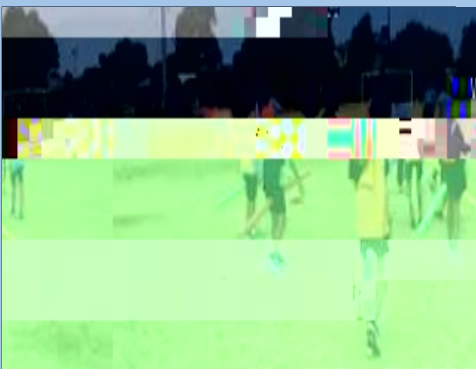


Students in STEM have been learning about animal adaptations.

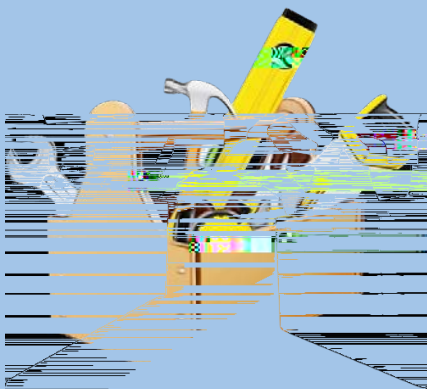
